

## Dear Rider/Visitor

We look forward to seeing you on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June for the Training/Schooling - Pick a fence!

Here are a few requests and some information you will require:

- The entrance to Little Whittington is a Hot Spot for cars overtaking.
   Please check and double check when turning in as we have had numerous accidents at the entrance! We have campaigned to the council to have road markings altered but so far with little success.
- On arrival please follow instructions for parking and leave 5 meters between you and the next horsebox/vehicle.
- Please keep 2 apart meters at all times, including between riders and people on foot.
- Unfortunately, this is not a social occasion (Due to covid rules).

  Therefore, we request you limit the amount of foot followers if possible.

  We do request you bring one other person either on horse or on foot.
- Dogs are not allowed on course at any time, due to nesting birds. If you
  have to bring your dog please keep on leads at all times and limit them
  to the parking field.
- Body protectors and the appropriate skull cap are compulsory.
- The course Is available to walk on day of 28<sup>th</sup> June 2020 at any time. Only if absolutely necessary you may walk after 3pm on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2020. Please be aware when walking the course on Sunday. There are no fence judges to blow a whistle when horses are coming, so please be alert.

- The course route is flagged with yellow markers and a number. You may pick whichever height you wish to jump at each individual fence, providing it has the number or a blank yellow marker. Where there are combinations you may choose 1 or more options.
- This is a very informal round of cross country and we request you are very sensible, especially as this is not a timed round (unless you wish to time yourself for practice).
- We will have stewards out on course, but you will not be marked. We
  aim to be as accommodating as possible with representing at a fence if
  you have a problem. We appreciate horses have not been out competing
  this year, so please do use this as a training round. However, you may be
  asked to move on if you are having reoccurring problems at a fence, to
  avoid any accidents or clashes with horses following.

We do not have medics on site; therefore you are schooling/training at your own risk. Our Stewards are first aid trained.

Sadly, we are unable to have a food van or toilets present at this event due to covid restrictions.

We hope you all have fun and enjoy being back out with your horses.
